Sanction

The Corkstown Classic is part of the NCD (National Capital District) race series.

Competition Rules for Classic Technique

Nordiq Canada rules apply. Please review and abide by rules for classic technique races.

Poles must be no longer than 83% of the skiers height for classical events.

Where there are one or more set tracks, repeatedly changing or stepping in and out of tracks is not allowed.

Single and double-skating is not allowed.

Race Distances and Fees

Distances raced will be determined by racer's age category as follows:

Age	Distance	Race Fee
U8 & U10	1.5 km	\$25
U12	3 km	\$30
U14	4 km	\$30
U16 & Open	8 km (2 x 4 km)	\$30
Para & Special Olympics	1.5 km	\$25

Registration Fees

Payable during registration on Zone4. The new Tier 3 License fee of \$3 as required by Nordiq Canada for additional insurance coverage will be added during registration. Zone4 transaction fees are extra. A refund in the amount of 50% will be offered if the race is cancelled to allow fixed and non refundable race costs to be covered.

Waxing Protocol

This race is a no-fluoro event. Only Non-Fluoro (NF) glide waxes are permitted to be used. Race participants are prohibited from using High-fluoro (HF), medium-fluoro (MF) or low-fluoro glide waxes, including HF or MF powders, pucks, blocks and liquids. This includes the use of cold weather powder additives & hardeners. Only Non-Fluoro grip waxes are permitted.

It is the responsibility of the athletes, coaches and parents to adhere to this requirement.

Waxing Area

While no indoor waxing facilities are available onsite, there will be a designated area where teams may set up their own tent and/or waxing tables.

On-Site Power

There is no onsite power for ski preparation.

Timing and Results

Timing will be carried out by Zone4. Participants will wear a timing chip. Results will be available on Zone4 soon after each race is complete.

Bib Pick Up

Bib pick-up will take place at one of the small cabins, located near the stadium. Bib pick up will start at 7:30AM on race day.

*Bibs must be returned upon crossing the finish line. There will be volunteers to assist with bib and timing chip removal in the finish area. Failure to return a bib will result in a \$75 charge to the club whose athlete did not return it.

Timing Chips

Wearable timing chips will be distributed to athletes upon entry to the stadium immediately prior to your start time. Failure to return your chip at the end of the race will result in a \$75 lost chip fee.

Racer Refreshments

Racers will be offered a drink and a snack upon finishing. Please ensure all recycling and waste gets appropriately disposed of on site.

Awards

Awards presentations will be held at the end of the Open/U16, U14/U12 and U10/U8, Para and Special Olympics races.

Awards will be presented as follows:

For U10-U14 categories, the first three finishers of each year of birth for both males and females.

For the U8, U16, Open and Para categories, the first three finishers for both male and female. All Special Olympics athletes will receive a medal.

Parking & Shuttle

Parking for race participants is available onsite. Please be considerate of others and park in a manner to maximize parking space. Parking volunteers will be directing vehicles. If space at the immediate race site is full, volunteers will ask you to unload athletes and ski gear and direct you to overflow parking (1km away) where a shuttle will be available.

Door Prizes

Will be awarded to participants by random draw and handed out following podium presentations.

First Aid

Provided by Canadian Ski Patrol and its members.

On Site Food

Bake sale items will be available for purchase. Please bring your coins! Participants are responsible for bringing food, water or warm drinks.






Full Trail System
